 color Guard will participate in a Strom Chasers game (tentatively scheduled for 5 Jun), Memorial
 Day, Ralston Parade, and Lincoln Veteran's Day parade, provided each event is not cancelled.
- Paul Burright and Ryan Fuller discussed the Wreaths across America Program. Only 20-25 people were allowed to place the wreaths. It took approximately two hours to place the wreaths. Our chapter donated 80 wreaths last year.

New Business:

 President, Ben Harvey, and Chapter Registrar, Paul Burright, installed new member Andrew Sullivan into the NESSAR.

The next meeting is scheduled to occur on 13 April 2021. There being no other business, all members rose and repeated "Until we meet again..." The meeting was adjourned at 2006 hours.
