- Ben Harvey and Paul Burright briefed the membership on a new opportunity for the chapter to
  obtain points for the Americanism report. We can receive points for attending funerals for
  POW/MIA military personnel identified by the Defense POW/MIA Accounting Agency, Offutt
  AFB.
- Paul Burright notified the membership that we are tentatively scheduled to clean up around the Chandler Chase Memorial at Prospect Hill Cemetery, Omaha on 19 June.
- Merl McAlevy reminded the membership that the State Meeting will be held at Mahoney State Park at 2:00PM on 16 May. The meeting will be a joint in-person and Zoom meeting.
